ABOUT INSPIRELI AWARDS

In the beginning, there was the idea of ex-president Vaclav Havel and prof. Borek Sipek to create a platform for support start-up architects internationally. In 2015, Prof. Borek Sipek and architecture psychologist Karel Smejkal launched the platform as a global talent contest INSPIRELI AWARDS. The aim was to promote young talented people in architecture, regardless of their economic, social or ethnic background. The competition gradually evolved from a simple show of photographic designs to a talent contest of student projects in the categories of architecture, urbanism, and interior design. Since 2019, INSPIRELI AWARDS has been registered in the Declaration of Architectural Associations of the Visegrad Group within the International Union of Architects. At the same time, since the 4th year of the competition, all finalists receive the so-called Certificate of Recognition of the American Institute of Architects, which allows them to become a member of this prestigious American organization after completing their studies. Over four years, thousands of students and young architects from 136 countries have participated in the competition, and INSPIRELI AWARDS has become one of the largest student competitions on the planet.

ABOUT THE COMPETITION OF THE EMBASSY

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Czech Republic decided to make use of the potential of the global INSPIRELI AWARDS competition and, in the spirit of the ideas of the founders, launched a student idea contest with the Department of Architecture of the Czech Technical University in Prague on a proposal for the Czech Republic's Embassy in Addis Ababa. The aim of the competition was to support students in their professional development and give them the opportunity to participate in the creation of a representative project. The competition was conducted as part of the INSPIRELI AWARDS student competition, as its separate category with its own commissioning and an expert jury made up of leading architects, academics as well as representatives of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Czech Republic. The interest in this prestigious project exceeded all the expectations of the contracting authorities. Over 470 students of 38 nationalities from each continent joined the competition, leaving the expert jury to select from an incredible 280 projects. The INSPIRELI AWARDS platform has shown that it cannot only connect students from around the planet but that it can offer them projects that allow them to realize their creative dreams. All of Ethiopia's Embassy projects also competed as student work in the INSPIRELI AWARDS talent competition in the Architecture category. Two projects from Argentina fought their way up into the absolute final.

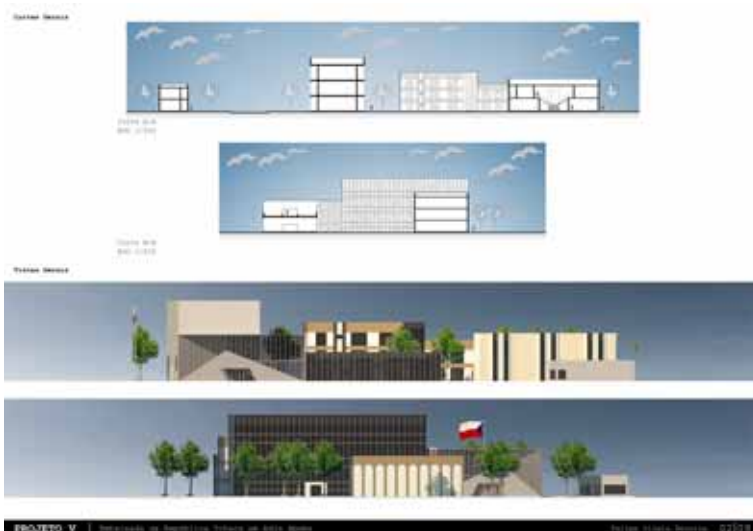


CONCEITO:
